Eligibility Criteria for

SMBC Bangkok Branch Scholarship Program for FY2019

To be eligible for the SMBC Bangkok Branch Scholarship Program, applicants must:

- 2nd to 4th year undergraduates from faculties/Departments related to
 - o Japanese Language & Culture or
 - o Law or
 - o Economics or

 - o Commerce
- Have a minimum CGPA 3.00 on 4.00 scale.
- Financial need*
- Extra-Curricular Activities and community activities

Application Period: August 19 – September 20, 2019

Amount : THB40,000 per grant

Target grantees: Bachelor's Degree students

Number : 6 grants

Qualified students are encouraged to contact the Student Affair Division at the university.

Note: *Guideline for financial need as follows;

Bangkok – Family income should not over THB420,000/year. Upcountry – Family income should not over THB300,000/year.
